# **2026 Miss Woodlake Lions Rodeo Queen, Jr. Queen & Princess Contest Overview**

**Applications due Wednesday, February 4, 2026**

The Miss Woodlake Lions Rodeo contest is held annually to select young ladies who will serve as positive role models. These young women represent the Woodlake Lions Club and the Woodlake Lions Rodeo throughout the year, promoting both the event and the sport of rodeo within the local Woodlake and Tulare County communities. **The newly crowned Miss Woodlake Lions Rodeo Queen will receive a saddle, crown, sash, and belt buckle. Jr. Queen & Princess will receive a crown, sash, & buckle**, provided the eligibility requirements are met and maintained throughout the reign of Queen, Jr. Queen & Princess. Prizes are awarded to all category winners.

## **Eligibility Requirements**

- Willing and able to fulfill all of the "Queen, Jr. Queen, or Princess responsibilities" during her reign.
- Single, never married, without children, and have not had any children previously.
- Never previously held the title of Miss Woodlake Lions Rodeo Queen, Jr. Queen, or Princess.
- Age requirements for Queen: 16-24 years old, Jr. Queen: 10-15 years old, & Princess: 6-9 years old, as of the Contest Orientation Meeting, Friday, February 6, 2026.

## **Contest Categories**

The 2026 Miss Woodlake Lions Rodeo Queen, Jr. Queen, & Princess, and runner-ups (court) will be selected based on the best scores in three categories: Horsemanship, Poise, Personality & Appearance, and Ticket Sales. In the case of a tie in overall scores, Ticket Sales will be the deciding factor.

## **Orientation Meeting**

**All contestants will need to attend the Contest Orientation meeting on Friday, February 6, 2026, at 6 p.m., at the Woodlake Community Center, located at 145 N. Magnolia Street in Woodlake.**

Orientation attire is a long-sleeved button-up shirt, western jeans, and a cowboy hat. Attendance is limited to the Contestant and parent(s)/legal guardian(s).
